REVISI IREX BANDUNG 2017:

Article 4: Condition and Participation

4.1 Competitive Exhibits Classes:

Exhibitors from (Federation Internationale de Philatelie) FIP member federations and Federation Inter-Asian Philately (FIAP) member federations who are not FIP members thereof shall be eligible for participating at BANDUNG 2017. An exhibitor who satisfies the following conditions may submit exhibits (for classes 1 to 7 and class 9, under Article 5.2 below): Entries winning at least a vermeil award at the National Exhibitions, (for classes 1 to 7 and class 9).

Article 5: Exhibition Classes

5.2 Competitive Classes:

Class 1: Traditional Philately

Class 2: Postal History

Class 3: Postal Stationery

Class 4: Aerophilately

Class 5: Thematic Philately

Class 6: Youth Philately

Class 7: Literature Philately

Class 8: One-Frame Exhibit

Class 9: Modern Philately (1980 to date)

Article 7: Frame Size and Allotment of Frames

- 7.2 All exhibits must be mounted on white. No exhibit mounted on dark colored or black pages will be accepted.
- 7.4 Every exhibit shall be allowed five (5) or eight(8) frames (with the exception of the classes 6, 7 and 8) according to GREX Articles 6.3 and 6.4.

Class 6: Youth Philately Groups

A: 1 - 3 frames

B: 2 - 4 frames

C: 3 – 5 frames

Class 8: One-Frame Exhibits 1 frame

Article 8: Application and Acceptance

8.3 Exhibit Application Forms duly filled shall be submitted through the respective Commissioners to the Commissioner General **not later than November 30**, **2016**. When submitting the Exhibit Application Form, the exhibitor shall attach a copy of the introductory page, in one of the FIP's official languages.

Article 9: Participation Fee

- 9.2 The participation fee for Competitive Classes (except Classes 6, 7 & 8) will be US\$75 per frame.
- 9.3 The participation fee for Youth Philately Class (Class 6) is free.
- The participation fee for Literature (Class 7) is US\$85 per exhibit.
- 9.5 The participation fee for One-Frame Exhibit (Class 8) is US\$100 per exhibit.

Article 10: Handling of Exhibits

Exhibitors in the Philatelic Literature Class (Class 7A, 7B and 7C) must send two copies of each title or volume – none of these are returnable. Periodicals shall exhibit a complete volume or year. Philatelic Literature exhibits must be received by the Organizing Committee **no later than May 20, 2017**, in order that preliminary judging may take place. The exhibits will not be returned. One set each of the exhibits will be kept by the Indonesian Philatelists Association and the other to be sent to FIP, mail charges to be born by the Organizing Committee.

Article 13: Security Measures

13.3 Every exhibitor has to insure his or her exhibit at own expense (GREX Article 50.2).
