Class 11 Modern

Exhibits in this class should predominantly contain material that has been issued in the 20 years prior to the exhibition, i.e. 2002. Acceptance will be based on the recommendation of National Commissioners and the discretion of the Cape Town 2022 Organising Committee. The 20 year will not be rigidly enforced. If the majority of the material falls inside the 20-year period, it can be shown as a Modern Philately exhibit. As an example of the flexibility that can be accommodated, a long-running definitive series with a time span that covers both before and after 2000 may be included if the majority of the material included is post-2000.

Entry Fees (as stated in the IREX)

- 8.1 The entry fee for five and eight-frame competitive classes will be \$65 per frame.
- 8.2 The entry fee for the one-frame competitive class will be \$80 per frame.
- 8.3 The entry fee in the Literature Class will be \$35 per entry.
- 8.4 Entry fees are not refundable.
- 8.5 Invoices for Frame fees will be sent by the Commissioner General to National Commissioners with the list of accepted entries. Payment must be made within 30 days of the invoice being sent.
